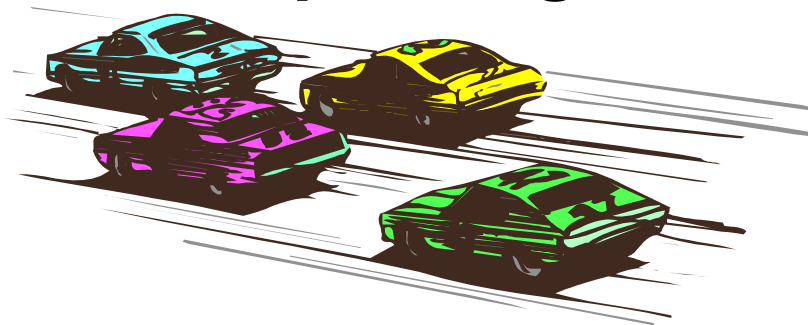

Speeding



Contrary to most beliefs, speeding saves relatively little time and creates a very high risk. Speeding also creates a negative image of the company. Remember, the technician's vehicle is a traveling billboard and reflects an overall attitude of the company. Speeding also creates a customer attitude about the company.

If you drive 10 miles an hour over the speed limit for ten miles, you will save a minute or two at best. This equates to a savings of maybe 10 minutes all day, if you speed everywhere. When speeding, the probability of having an accident is increased significantly, not to mention the probability of getting a ticket.

The consequences of either of these events will most likely lead to loss of money, significant loss of time, increased insurance rates and a negative image of the company, not to mention the possibility of an accident and personal injury. If you have an accident or get a ticket, the time lost will greatly off set any time saved by speeding.

The minute saved is insignificant and not worth the risk.
