Power Tool Recall



Three power tool manufacturers are recalling about 180,000 power tools. The switches on these power tools, which were manufactured by Eaton Corporation of Cleveland, Ohio, can stick. The tools can continue to operate after the trigger has been released, posing a risk of injury to consumers. S-B Power Tools Company, of Chicago, Illinois, is recalling Bosch-brand drills; Makita U.S.A. Incorporated, of La Mirada, California, is recalling Makita-brand rotary hammers, drills and screwdrivers; and Milwaukee Electric Tool Corporation, of Brookfield, Wisconsin, is recalling Milwaukee Electric Tool-brand band saws.

The following lists the power tools included in this recall. The model number can be found written on the power tool.
