School is Back in Session

It's fall and school is back in session. Traffic is heavier, slower and drivers are more cautious. We too must slow down and be more careful.

This means school zones are again operational and traffic is heavier. Kids will be present everywhere; walking inside and outside of the school crossings and school traffic zones. Unfortunately, they often do not notice traffic, and run out from behind or between cars.



While driving when school zones are in effect, we must have a heightened awareness of our surroundings. We should also maintain this awareness during daytime hours even when school zones are not active. At times, children have to leave school for various reasons throughout the school day. It is imperative that we exercise caution at all times throughout the day.

When approaching a school bus, do not pass it if the stop sign is out and the bus' lights are flashing, or if children are present. The only time you can pass a stopped school bus is when it is on the opposite side of a divided highway or road. Children have the right-of-way and may run out in front of the bus to cross the street.
