See The Road

Eos: The **SAFE** Driver Improvement System™ teaches us many techniques for protecting yourself from the mistakes of others on the roadway. This year, we will review some of the core techniques taught in Eos in the distribution of these monthly safety tips.

The first of the four key positive activities taught in Eos is “See the Road”. To see the road is to look ahead as far as you can see to spot hazards and analyze and understand them. Consider the following as you attempt to develop your driving skills and incorporate this positive activity.

- Raise your eyes to see down the roadway as far as possible. This may be only a couple of blocks in the city or for a mile or more on the open road.
- Identify potential hazards and analyze and understand the risk they pose.
- Adjust to potential hazards far in advance of need. Have a plan to deal with potential threats to avoid having to quickly react to a situation.



By training yourself to look ahead as far as possible when driving, you will be able to recognize hazards as early as possible. Spotting potential hazards early allows you to develop a plan far in advance of need. This is your best defense against traffic hazards and a key positive activity that will help you protect yourself from the mistakes of others on the roadway.
