Basic Job Steps	Potential Hazards	Controls & Recommended Actions
1. locate the problem	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> insect stings, trip/slip fall hazards, dogs 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> put on bee gear before approaching the area of complaint preview path of travel prior to getting equipment
2. determine equipment/chemical needs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">
3. set up equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> insect stings strains pinch points trip/slip fall 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use proper body mechanics to avoid twisting Determine your clear path of travel on your trip when you locate complaint and before carrying your equipment wear your PPE
4. begin treatment steps	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> insect stings falls from ladder chemical exposure 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> familiarize yourself with your chemical use prior to use on the job site wear all PPE indicated on the chemical use proper ladder use technique and proper ladder setup guidelines
5. take down and return equipment to truck	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> same as step #3 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> same as step #3
